Summary

This route involves visiting the most northerly, easterly, southerly and westerly points in Wales. The points can be done in any order. I decided to go clockwise, starting in the East (Chepstow) and then going South (Barry Island), West (St. David's) and North (Point of Ayre). I broke the journey with an overnight stay in Aberystwyth.


The Challenge

Distance: 320 Miles (by quickest route)

Time to complete: 2 days

Riding Time: 7 ¾ hours (by quickest route)
